The 2018 Florida Regional Extrication Challenge will see up to 15 rescue teams from all over Florida participate in a team based scenario training exercise designed to promote good team dynamics, improve communications and increase rescue scene proficiency. Each team will consist of six members, the team leader, a medic, three technical rescue personnel and one person responsible for both medical and technical operational support.

All teams compete in two scenarios and additional training evolutions.

- **20min. Standard**, where the team will perform a rescue operation involving multiple vehicles and will be assessed on their ability to survey the scene, create & execute an extrication plan, package & remove one **STABLE** entrapped casualty. All tools are available.
- **10min. Rapid**, The scenario criteria is the same as the “Standard” with the one exception, the one casualty becomes **UNSTABLE** and time critical. All tools are available.

The 2018 Florida Regional Extrication Challenge is open to all teams and entry will be based on the first 15 paid entries. This challenge is a North American Vehicle Rescue Association (NAVRA) sanctioned event and participation will qualify teams for further National and International Rescue Challenges.

Team information meeting will be on the night of June 6th.

Host hotel – Holiday Inn, The individual teams will need to contact Courtney Woznek herself via her cell to get the agreed price which is \$120 per night which does include breakfast. There is a block of 20 rooms reserved for the time frame Wednesday June 5th through Saturday June 9th. In order to ensure room availability rooms must be reserved no later than May 11th after that the rooms will be released and the price cannot be guaranteed. While teams are not required to stay there, hotel rooms get much more expensive the closer you get to the beach. The hotel is only about a 10 minute drive from the Fire academy, 15-20 drive from the beach, and only about a 5 minute drive from the St. John's Town Center which is a large outdoor shopping mall with endless places to eat.
